Supporting Pupils

- To develop an understanding of the educational needs of the pupils involved
- To assist pupils to learn as effectively as possible in class, group and individual situations
- To work with pupils individually or in pairs or groups to help develop their understanding across the curriculum and particularly of mathematics and literacy
- To establish a supportive relationship with pupils concerned
- To encourage the integration of the pupils into the class
- To help promote and reinforce the pupils' confidence, self-esteem and independence
- To help keep pupils on task, build motivation and maintain appropriate behaviour
- To support pupil premium pupils to reach their targets

Supporting the SEN Co-ordinator/Subject Teacher

 To assist in the development, implementation and review of the individual targets and intervention programmes for pupils including pupil premium pupils











- To monitor and record pupils' progress
- To contribute to the evaluation of support programmes by providing regular feedback about pupils to the teacher
- To contribute, where appropriate, to statutory reviews of a pupil's EHCP.

Supporting the School

- To liaise, advise and consult with other members of the team supporting the pupils when asked to do so
- To attend relevant in-service training
- To promote the safety and well-being of pupils in accordance with the school's Child Protection and other relevant policies including the health and safety policy.
