Our team of PE staff work incredibly hard to ensure every student has the opportunity to engage and make progress in a variety of sporting activities.

The department is a very active and collaborative place to be where teamwork ensures teaching and learning and extra curricular provision are both of the highest standard.

Our Facilities

We are in the privileged position of having fantastic sporting facilities, a sign of our whole school commitment to health and well-being for all stakeholders. We have a large sports centre and 4G pitch.

In addition to this, we have a sports centre, gym, sports hall, fitness suite, a football pitch, a rugby pitch and an outdoor court area comprising of nine tennis courts, six netball courts and two futsal courts.

All staff are provided with a laptop, and PE have access to an IT suite for Level 2 and Level 3 BTEC lessons.

Our Curriculum

We have implemented an exciting and varied curriculum and a culture of praise in the department in order to promote high engagement.

As part of Core PE in Years 7-11, students develop their knowledge and skills across 12 different sports throughout the year.

Core PE is currently taught in single gender groups and classes are also split by ability.

At Key Stage 4, GCSE PE and BTEC Sport Level 2 are on offer and at Key Stage 5 both the A Level PE and BTEC Sport Level 3 route can be followed. Our examination results are consistently good and the subject remains highly popular.

Our extra-curricular programme is one to be proud of, with a lunchtime and after school club programme available for all students to attend. We have an extensive competitive fixture programme with district, county and national fixtures in a range of sports including netball, hockey, football, rugby, basketball, cricket and athletics.

We also run an annual sports tour, considered to be one of the best memories of students' time at Latimer, and an annual trip to Wimbledon. As well as this, the year culminates in a whole school House Sports Day.

This a highly motivating and energetic department with high expectations resulting in high outcomes for the students.
